- No lip-syncing, please.

By submitting a talent video, you grant permission for the video and your child's first name & grade to be included in this online production. The show will be limited to 35 acts. Be sure to submit your video on time!

VIDEO TAPE PROCEDURES & TIPS

- Students 1st-8th Grader Performers
- Only single performer acts unless performed by a family living in the same household.
- Time limit: **2 minutes 30 seconds** per act, start to finish
- At the beginning of your video, state your full name, grade, and performance description.
- Film HORIZONTALLY (landscape), not vertically
- When you're filming - Be Quiet to avoid excess background noise. The microphone is closest to the person holding the device.
- When you're performing - BE LOUD. Project your voice so that it reaches the microphone.
- Film in a well-lit area. Turn on all of your lights.
- Use a tripod or position the camera on a flat surface for stability.
- If using a phone or tablet to record:
 - hold it HORIZONTALLY (landscape), not vertically
 - place the lens on the bottom right side
 - use the top volume button as a start/stop button
- Think about the composition of your shot. Try to make the viewers eye look at the performance. In most cases, center the performer in the middle. If you zoom in/out or change your angle during the video, do it slowly to avoid sudden or jerky movements.
- **Label your video file** with your first name, last name, and grade. Ex: MarySmith-3rdGrade
- Maximum file size: 500 MB
