A Note From The Teacher

Superkid Izzy loves interesting information and introduced Kindergarteners to the short /i/ sound. This week we will use our blending skills to read *Izzy's Books*. We will identify words that have the short /i/ as the initial or medial sound in a word. Students will put their letter isolation skills to work to write a simple sentence. Writing sentences helps us practice our handwriting, spacing and punctuation skills. In Math, a number line will help us count on and find sums. Kindergarten Scientists begin to explore Force and Motion, starting with the concept of Push. The new sight words are **up, did**.




