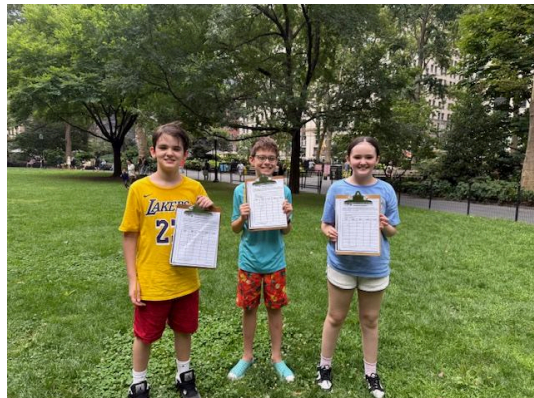
DAILY SCHEDULE OVERVIEW
