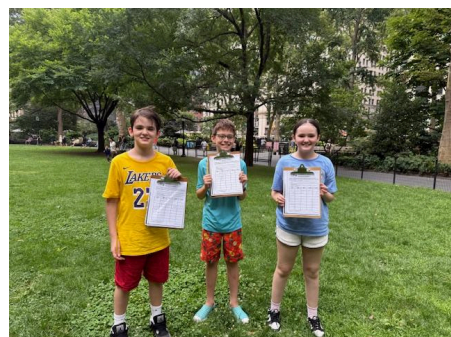
## DAILY SCHEDULE OVERVIEW

## OTHER HELPFUL INFO

- All campers must be fully potty trained according to the same [guidelines](#) as our Nursery program, except for the use of Pull-Ups. Pull-Ups are not permitted at camp due to water play.
- Campers should bring a backpack containing lunch, 2 snacks, water bottle, sunblock, and towel. Students in 2nd and 3rd should also bring a silent reading book. Bathing suits and water shoes are recommended for onsite days with water play.
- Students are expected to abide by the behavioral guidelines of The Epiphany School Family Handbook.
- Students may not use cell phones, smart watches, or other personal electronics while at camp.
